**Overnight at your Jerusalem hotel (David Citadel or Mamilla hotel)**

**Sunday, March 29, 2020 (breakfast, lunch, dinner included)**

- Breakfast

**Be sure to have your passports easily accessible.**

*We suggest that you bring an overnight bag to Jordan and leave your main luggage at your Jerusalem hotel. Our team will bring your luggage to Ben Gurion airport for you on March 31. Be sure your luggage has a clearly printed name tag on it. If you are flying home directly from Jordan, bring all your luggage with you.*

**7.30am** Departure from Jerusalem to Ben Gurion airport (domestic terminal)

**10.00am** Flight to Ramon airport, Eilat

**11.00am** Arrival to Eilat and transfer from the airport to the Arava / Rabin border crossing

- Assistance with our border team at both the Israeli and Jordanian terminals
- Meeting with your Jordanian guide and driver to begin your touring in the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan
- Lunch followed by visit to Wadi rum – 4x4 ride into the desert headquarters of Lawrence of Arabia
- Drive to Wadi Moussa (home of Petra)

**Dinner and overnight: Old Village, Petra**

**Monday, March 30, 2020 (breakfast, lunch, dinner included)**

- Breakfast
- Full day visit to the Nabatean red rose capital city of Petra. Enjoy a guided morning tour with your guide followed by time to discover Petra on your own. Time to climb to the high places, explore the caves and chasms of Petra. Enjoy lunch.
- Return to your hotel at your leisure.

**Dinner and overnight: Old Village, Petra**

**Tuesday, March 31, 2020 (breakfast, lunch included) Be sure to have your passports easily accessible**

- Breakfast
- Drive north through the Jordanian countryside
- Madaba – Visit the St. George church with its 4th century mosaic map of the middle east
- Lunch
- Mount Nebo – where Moses looked into the Promised Land but could not enter
- Proceed to the King Hussein / Allenby bridge
- Assistance with our border team at both the Jordanian and Israeli terminals
- Meeting with your driver for transfer directly to Ben Gurion International airport for your flight home.

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### Travel Tips for Jordan:

1. On Israeli domestic flights (to/from Eilat), each passenger can bring 1 suitcase weighing up to 20 kgs & one small shoulder bag to bring on board. Be sure to have your passport easily accessible.
2. U.S. Dollars and Jordanian Dinars are the accepted currencies in Jordan. You will have the opportunity to exchange money at banks on either side of the border. Just as in Israel we do not accept Jordanian Dinars, they do not accept Shekels. You can easily exchange Dinars back to Shekels. Dollars or Euros at the border if you are returning to Israel. We always suggest using local currencies. ATM machines are available in most areas, which accept major credit cards and give instructions in English.
3. It is prohibited to bring food or beverages across the border between Israel and Jordan. Sometimes the border crossing takes time, your patience is appreciated
4. Please note that as there is no Rabbinate in Jordan, there is no kosher food readily available. All of the meals on this program are based on buffet meals (including a variety of salads, beef and chicken dishes). There are no pork products on any of the buffets. Should any of our guests require kosher food, please let us know in advance and we will "make it happen."
5. As Middle East tradition will have it, expect to be approached by people (often children) attempting to sell souvenirs, coins, carpets, and all kinds of objects. Whether or not you make a purchase from them is certainly your decision. Be aware that often the items that the merchant claims to be "ancient" or "Roman" are not. On site, your guide will not be able to tell you that the items for sale are not antiquities – so we are advising you of this in advance. If during the course of your tour locals approach you asking any special tips or payment, simply refer them to your guide or driver. They are there for you not only to provide you with information, but as a "bridge between cultures."
6. We always suggest to our guests to purchase travel insurance, so that you'll be covered in case you have to delay or cancel this excursion due to unexpected circumstances after payment has been made.
7. Should you prefer to bring an overnight bag to Jordan and leave your luggage in Jerusalem while you are in Jordan, we will transfer your luggage to Ben Gurion airport to meet you on March 31.
8. Gratuities to your guide and driver have not been included in your package. Don't forget that this is the best way to express your appreciation for the service they have provided you during your stay.

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#### Schedule of payment for Jordan extension:

- **Non-refundable deposit of usd350** per participant is due by **September 1, 2019**. The final price of the Jordan extension was determined based on the number of deposits we received. (keeping the per person price as low as possible)
- Payment for the Jordan extension can be done by credit card (AmEx, Visa, Mastercard), check or bank/wire transfer. All payment information will be sent to participants by e mail.
- There is a 3 percent credit card fee supplement on all payments
- **Payment in full is due by January 10, 2020. The final balance will be charged automatically.** Receipts and confirmation of services booked for deposits have been sent to each participant. Upon our receiving final payment, we will again send receipts. For those paying by check or bank/wire transfer, it is their responsibility to be sure that Kenes Tours receives payment on time.
